



SCRIPTURE PASSAGES

Session 52: Saved from the Wrath of God

Romans 1:18

¹⁸For God's wrath is revealed from heaven against all godlessness and unrighteousness of people who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.

Romans 5:6-9

⁶For while we were still helpless, at the appointed moment, Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷For rarely will someone die for a just person—though for a good person perhaps someone might even dare to die. ⁸But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us! ⁹Much more then, since we have now been declared righteous by His blood, we will be saved through Him from wrath.

Hebrews 10:1-4,11-14

¹Since the law has only a shadow of the good things to come, and not the actual form of those realities, it can never perfect the worshipers by the same sacrifices they continually offer year after year. ²Otherwise, wouldn't they have stopped being

offered, since the worshipers, once purified, would no longer have any consciousness of sins? ³But in the sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. ⁴For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

¹¹Now every priest stands day after day ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. ¹²But this man, after offering one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God. ¹³He is now waiting until His enemies are made His footstool. ¹⁴For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are sanctified.

1 John 4:17-18

¹⁷In this, love is perfected with us so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment; for we are as He is in this world. ¹⁸There is no fear in love; instead, perfect love drives out fear, because fear involves punishment. So the one who fears has not reached perfection in love.
